ECCMID Clinical Grand Rounds 2018 – call for cases

Dear (sub-)committee members,

At the next ECCMID in Madrid we will again hold the educational session “Clinical Grand Rounds”, where training fellows will for 15 minutes discuss a case from their own institutions with a panel of experts.

Please encourage training fellows who are fluent in English and capable of presenting to a large audience to submit abstracts of a case (one A4 page only).

Ideally, the presented case should depict a realistic and representative scenario on a hospital ward round. It should be clinically challenging with demanding therapeutic decisions to make and also contain elements of microbiology/virology/mycology/parasitology, good pathology and other investigations such as imaging.

Based on power-point presentations of the shortlisted abstracts the session organizers will select the six best cases for presentation. ECCMID will cover the registration fee and the travel costs according to the attached ECCMID rules and regulations for speakers and chairs. For the presenting fellows the speaker rules apply.

Please ask your fellows to send the **case abstract by 4 December 2017** to the ECCMID Scientific Secretariat (eccmid@eccmid.org). ATTENTION: The case abstracts need to be submitted by email, not through the ECCMID abstract system.

Should you know a colleague, whose fellow has an interesting case to present, you may well forward this invitation to her/him.
