

- ✓ stand-alone specialty, separated from Internal Medicine as well as from Microbiology & Virology
- ✓ several schools across the country (University hospitals)



# Infectious diseases in Italy: training

## The changes occurred in 2015:

- ✓ national selection (a mix of
- **Spanish and French models)**
- ✓ merge with Tropical Diseases
- ✓ duration from 5 to 4 years (to strike a balance between lack of funding and necessity to increase the number of positions)
- ✓ just a few weeks of common trunk in Internal Medicine (previously, 6 months)

There is a national curriculum, but its implementation is quite








# Trainee Association of ESCMID (TAE)





## Purpose

The TAE Award for Training Achievements is intended to recognize and reward outstanding trainees in clinical microbiology and infectious diseases.

## Funding

The TAE Award for Training Achievements will be presented during the 28th ECCMID in Madrid and includes:

- A non-restricted prize money of EUR 1,500
- ECCMID 2018 travel and registration
- Summer School 2018 registration and accommodation

Reimbursement of registration fee and travel expenses will take place after the event upon proof of attendance and proof of expenses paid, e.g. boarding cards, tickets, receipts and registration fees.

We will select a maximum of two awardees in either clinical microbiology or infectious disease specialties. The awardees will be honored during ECCMID at the TAE Trainees Day and the Young Scientists reception.

## Eligibility criteria

- Candidates must be nominated by an individual familiar with his/her work who is a superior / staff member / head of department. Self applications will not be considered.
- The nominee must be an ESCMID member in good standing and should be an ESCMID Young Scientist Member (under 35-years-of-age or under 40 years-of-age and in training).
